I have reviewed the District Court of Oklahoma - Official Transcript of the Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner's testimony in the above case as well as, the Official Transcript of Article 14 which is The Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner's Report.

Experience and /or Qualifications for Pediatric Sexual Assault Testimony

I was unable to locate a resume or curriculum vitae in the court records although they may have existed at that time. The Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner, Megan Sinclair did testify regarding her credentials as being a Registered Nurse with specialized training to perform pediatric sexual assault exams (a Pediatric SANE nurse). Also, that she did see Clayton Woolley a 5 y/o patient on 3/31/18 and that she did perform a sexual assault exam on the child Clayton Woolley.

Upon review of her sexual assault (SANE) exam report. I found that Nurse Sinclair used forms that designate her Sexual Assault Exam patient Clayton as a victim. The forms she used are identified as: "KIDS' SPACE MCCAC REPORT RAPE PROGRAM" in the footer section of the exam records.

The narrative section is titled "VICTIM'S DESCRIPTION OF ASSAULT" on the two pages of the narrative found within her SANE exam report. This is the section where she obtained a medical history from the patient Clayton Woolley.

Leading Questions and Extensive interviewing by Nurse Sinclair of a Pediatric Patient

I have identified that Nurse Sinclair did ask leading questions that she documented in the narrative section.

Line 10 - on 1st page of narrative:

"Asked Pt if he had ever seen anyone put their privates on anyone else's body, "

Line 14 - on 1st page of narrative:

"Asked Pt where it happens"

Line 16 – on 1st page of narrative:

"When asked where everyone else is when Papa puts his privates in Elijah, "

Line 19 – on 1st page of narrative:

"When asked what Papa's privates look like, "

Line 21 – 1st page of narrative :

"Asked Pt if Papa did it to Elijah 1X or lots of times,"

Line 23 – 1st page of narrative:

“When asked where Papa’s hands are when he does it to Elijah,”

Line 25 1st page of narrative:

“Asked Pt if anyone had ever put their private parts on him,”

Line 27 1st page of narrative continued to 2nd page of narrative:

“ when asked pt if anyone saw Papa do that to him,”

Findings:

The Pediatric SANE medical history taken from Clayton was leading, too extensive and not appropriate for a child of 5 years of age.

Conclusion:

It is my opinion that the SANE nurse Meagan Sinclair did testify and provide documentation of the medical Pediatric SANE history to the court that is beyond the scope of practice for a Pediatric SANE nurse.
